Need to Know

MIDTERM EXAMS

<u>Here</u> is the schedule for Midterms week. **Please review carefully as there are 3 different schedules**. The schedule for 6th grade students is first. The schedules for students in grades 7-12 are based on lunch period.

If a student does not have an exam, they do not need to report to school. If a student is going to be out for a full day due to not having an exam, the parent or guardian must call the school or email attendance@tfanh.org.

Buses will run at regular times in the morning and afternoon. Students can be dismissed at 12:30 when exams are over via car pickup. Drop off and pickup will follow the regular pattern before 7:45am and at 12:30pm.

Students who are in school when they do not have an exam will be in a silent study hall.

Please review the following message from the traffic team regarding 12:30 pick up:

Dear Parents -

During our midterm exam week, a lot of parents will be picking up their students at the same time - which can become a traffic nightmare! Here are a few requests to help make this go smoothly:

- 1.) We know that some parents will come by during their lunch hour from work to pick up their children, so if you are able to be flexible with what time you pick your student up, then please aim to pick them up around 12:50. Let the 12:30 pick-up be for those parents who need to get back to work or have a pressing appointment.
- 2.) All student pick-ups from 12:30-1:00pm will be in the back of the school. (This is obviously different to those parents used to picking up their children at the 2:35 early-dismissal time.) Just like morning drop-off, the parking lots will be one way around the school until most students have been picked up.
- 3.) If you see the line getting very long and ending almost on Perimeter Road, then please park in one of the upper parking lots for a few minutes and wait to join the line once it gets more reasonable. (If the traffic pattern on Perimeter gets messed up, then it will slow things down for all of us.)
- 4.) Remind your children to head right out to the pick-up area in the back of the school as soon as they can once they are dismissed. The quicker all students get into their cars, the quicker we can dismiss each "wave" of cars.

Who can apply? Any parent or guardian of a Founders Academy student

What are the duties of a Founders Board member? We set policies, hire and evaluate the school director, work with our parent organization (the PTSG), oversee the budget, fundraise, community relations, and other tasks, as needed to ensure the continued strength and success of the school. We ask that you participate in monthly board meetings, join a minimum of one committee and attend as many community events as possible

Who is on the board today? Angela Seggie (parent representative), Frank Weiss, Kimberley Lavallee (co-founder and vice-chair), Kyle Fox (treasurer), Patricia Humphrey (co-founder and secretary) and Robert Best (chairman).

When does the board meet? Every third Wednesday of the month at 6PM at our school. We encourage interested members to attend a Board of Trustees Meeting to observe what type of issues are discussed and how important decisions affecting The Founders Academy are made. The next meeting of the Board of Trustees will be held on Wednesday, November 16th, starting at 6:00 PM in the room to the left of the hallway after you pass through our main entrance.

What is the process to become a board member? The Parent Advisory Committee formed by the board, will invite the interested parents to meet with our parent advisory committee November 14th and/or 15th to learn more about you and answer your questions. On November 16th we invite all nominees for a parent board seat to the board meeting to meet current board members and participate in a short question and answer period. The board will conduct a vote that evening and the new term will start at the January board meeting.

There is now an electronic portal for parents to see state testing results. Families need a unique ID-stay tuned for more information on how to get yours!



Traffic Pattern

- 1. Do not let your child out of the car until they see a traffic attendant with the "walk" sign showing. Safety is a top priority.
- 2. Students should be dropped off and picked up in the back of the building only, except for 2:25 dismissal.
- 3. All cars should pull up as far as possible in the back of the building. Do not stop until you cannot go any further.
