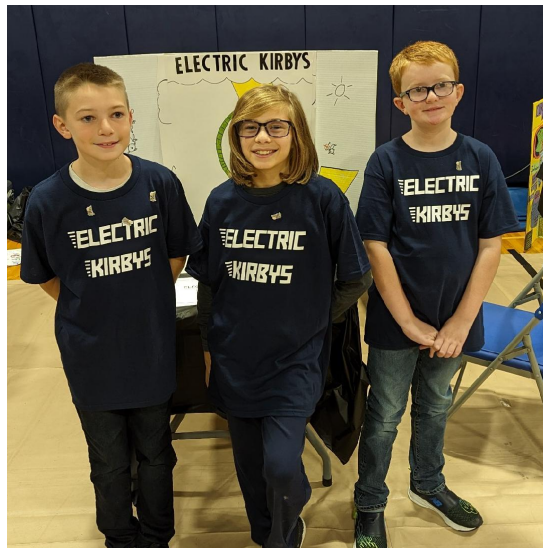




Dean of School's Report ~ November 30, 2022

4. **Admissions Update:** Admissions for the 2023-2024 school year opened on September 15, 2022 and closes on March 15, 2023. To date we've received 27 total applications and 22 of those are complete. We've had 13 applications for 5th grade, 8 for 6th grade, 3 for 7th grade, 2 for 8th grade, and 1 for 9th grade. We've had two well-attended admissions info nights and have two more scheduled for the school year. We are discussing the addition of a Saturday admissions info session.
5. **Student Spotlight:**
Logan is on a middle school robotics team in Londonderry and his 5th grade robotics team (a 3 person team) had its competition a few weeks ago. His team qualified top 6, and qualified for states this weekend.



6. **Day of Giving:** Our 24-hour GivingTuesday campaign that encouraged families and supporters to donate and show their support of our school and mission raised \$5,8088.88. This day was advertised heavily on our social media pages, website, newsletters, and emails from Dean Hayes. Most donations were raised online through our PayPal link, but we did bring in about \$700 from morning and afternoon carline the day of the event.
