NHETG Workshops Field Trip

Last Friday Ms. Mote brought her Theatre I class to the theatre workshops put on by the New Hampshire Educational Theatre Guild at Plymouth State University. It was a special opportunity for our students as they learned about creative techniques in make-up, lighting, and sound. They listened to actors and directors discuss their experience with the storytelling process, and received advice for auditioning and applying to college theatre programs. They were even taught some Broadway choreography!

The highlight of the trip was seeing Plymouth State's production of Shakespeare's Much Ado About Nothing-a show that our students enjoyed so immensely that many of them wanted to see it again! Our students had a great time, and they are already looking forward to next year's workshops.

Attending the NHETG workshops was such a positive experience that Ms. Mote hopes to organize a similar theatre workshop event for middle school students in the near future!









Overnight Field Trip Info Night: Nov 1st

This year, two overnight field trips are being organized for students. These trips are optional and students must meet specific criteria to be able to attend - including having minimal discipline issues. There will be a few fundraisers that students can participate in to lower their costs.

Philadelphia/Gettysburg/Washington/Baltimore - This 5-day trip is open to students who are currently in OR have already completed History 3 (US History I). Highlights of this trip include: Independence Hall, the National Constitution Center, Valley Forge, Gettysburg, the White House, the Supreme Court, the National Archives, the Library of Congress, Arlington National Cemetery, the major monuments and memorials in and around Washington, DC, Mount Vernon, Fort McHenry, and the National Aquarium. The dates for this trip will be Monday, April 16th to Friday, April 20th. (This is the week BEFORE April vacation.) Because students will miss class time on this trip, they will be responsible to talk to their teachers about making up any missed work. The cost of this trip will be approximately \$850-950.

New York City - This 2-day trip is open to students who are members of the Level 3 Band or Chorus, Level 4 Band or Chorus, and select members of the high school Drama Club. In addition, several members of the high school Drama Club for The Academy for Science and Design will also join us. Highlights of this trip include: a Q&A session with a Broadway performer, a trip to the Metropolitan Museum of Art, a visit to Times Square, a nighttime visit to the top of the Empire State Building, and attendance at Broadway Show. (The current plan for the show is Andrew Lloyd Weber's "School of Rock" - which is based on the movie.) The dates for this trip will be Tuesday, June 19th and Wednesday, June 20th. (The last day of school for the year at The Founders Academy is Friday, June 8th, so this will be during the beginning of summer vacation.) The cost of this trip will be approximately \$450-550.


