SAS Makeup Days

SAS makeup for grades 6-8 will be during final exam week on **June 8, 9, and 10**. The makeups will be held in the afternoon after finals, at **12:45 pm**. There will be one makeup test per day. Students who need to make up the SAS test should plan to stay for the afternoon session during final exam week to complete the testing.

Middle School Field Day

All Tech Camp Online and In-Person Summer Programs Offered Free to Participants!

UNH Tech Camp was founded more than a decade ago to inspire middle and high school students (grades 5-12) through collaborative, hands-on activities that bring science, technology, engineering and mathematics to life. Tech Camp is open to all levels of experience — an inquisitive mind and sense of adventure are all that are required to enroll!

This summer, Tech Camp is offering free online sessions for grades 5-12 that explore a range of STEM-related subject areas — from computer coding and robotics to forensic science and structural engineering — through a dynamic, project-based learning format that emphasizes creative thinking and problem solving.

New, in-person sessions focused on regenerative medicine and biofabrication are also being offered for grades 8-12 at Dover High School. These sessions are part of NH CREATES, a workforce development initiative at UNH. All required COVID-19 safety protocols will be followed.

Tech Camp is committed to fostering a diverse and inclusive community. Students from all ethnic, cultural and socioeconomic backgrounds are encouraged to apply!

Please note that space in all Tech Camp programs is limited. To be considered for one of the available slots, we are requiring that all students complete an online application.
